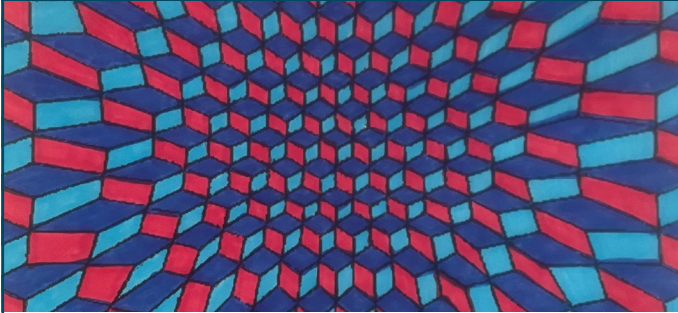

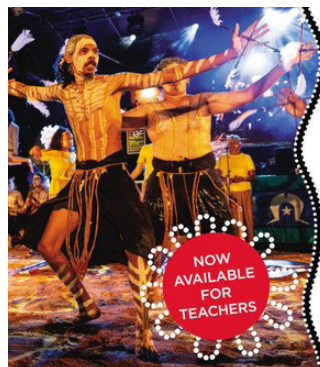
50 Treasures Revisited temporary exhibition
